Instructions to join via web browser


Join the meeting

Click the meeting link on the Notice of Annual General Meeting.

Please use a modern web browser such as Google Chrome,


Edge, or Firefox [more details]



You will be asked if you would like to open Microsoft Teams in the application.

Click 'cancel', you do not want to select 'Open Microsoft Teams' as this will ask you to create an account.

Click 'Join on the web instead', don't download the app.



Choose your audio and video settings

You may choose to turn on your camera if you wish but are also welcome to join with no camera.

We kindly ask that you enter the meeting with


Your **microphone turned off** (on mute) so as not

Make sure you enter your name, so the organiser knows who is joining.

Click 'Join Now'

Participation in the Meeting


Voting

Click the message/chat icon to view the meeting chat. This is where the links for voting will be placed (at the appropriate times). Keep this open for the entire duration of the meeting.

Please note that if you have submitted a proxy vote you will not need to vote during the meeting.

When it is time to vote, a link will be added to the 'chat' screen. Please click on the link, place your vote and hit submit.





Asking Questions

At various times throughout the meeting, the Chair will ask members if they have questions.

If you have a question, raise your hand and this will notify the Chair that you want to talk.

Please then wait to be called to ask your question. The Teams moderator will unmute your microphone at this time.
